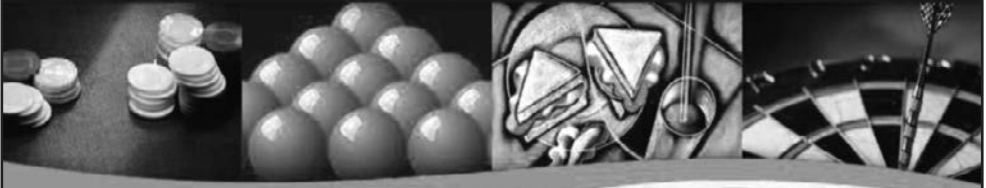

However it was Mr Wagon who had made the earlier headlines taking out two professionals, Gerard Greene and Barry Hawkins in previous rounds. Another fellow professional, Stuart Bingham claimed the highest break of the day with a 111. Special commendation should also go to Sean O'Sullivan and James Loft who played superbly to reach the semi-finals.

After narrowly losing out to Katie Henrick in the Cup, Charlie Walters went on to win the Plate competition. He played wonderfully throughout with a couple of 90+ breaks and eventually triumphed over Steve Whybrow in the final to take the prize.

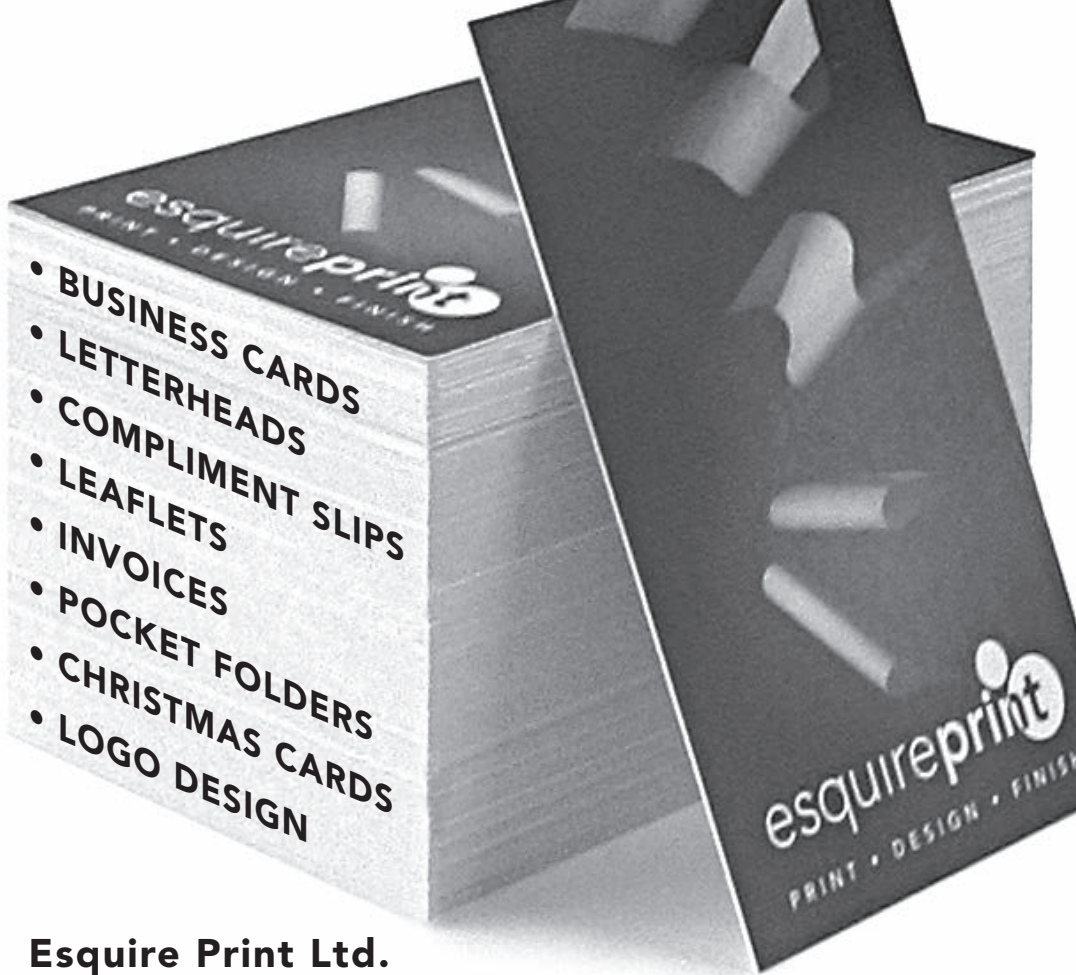
